Members of the benefice Patronage Board, including representatives of the Martyrs Memorial Church of England Trust, and the Bishop of Sherborne, acting on behalf of the Bishop of Salisbury, are delighted to announce the appointment of the Revd Dominic Meering as the next Team Rector, this is subject to the usual checks. Dom is currently Associate Vicar of Holy Trinity Church, Hazelmere in Buckinghamshire.



He will come to Ferndown and Hampreston having much experience of a large multi-congregational church, which has a growing ministry involving all-ages. Dom brings a passion for developing leadership and discipleship, for schools' work, outreach, pastoral care, team working and vision building. We look forward to him moving to Dorset with his wife Crystal and his two children in the summer.

Dom's institution, induction and installation as Team Rector by the Bishop of Salisbury will take place at 7pm on 12<sup>th</sup> September.

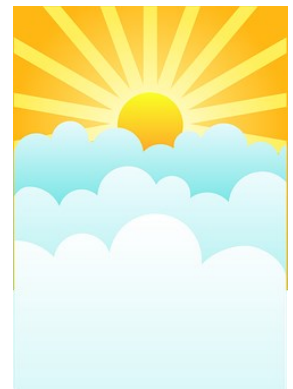

## Jesus Comes to Jerusalem as King John 12: 12-16



<sup>12</sup> The next day the great crowd that had come for the festival heard that Jesus was on his way to Jerusalem. <sup>13</sup> They took palm branches and went out to meet him, shouting, "Hosanna!" "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!", "Blessed is the king of Israel!" <sup>14</sup> Jesus found a young donkey and sat on it, as it is written:

<sup>15</sup> "Do not be afraid, Daughter Zion; see, your king is coming, seated on a donkey's colt."<sup>6</sup>

At first his disciples did not understand all this. Only after Jesus was glorified did they realize that these things had been written about him and that these things had been done to him.
