#### Sermon Series: Summer Term 2024 - The Book of 1 Corinthians

**Church is a people with purpose** ... But what does it mean to be fully united in the purpose that Jesus give us, and how do we do that here at All Saints and St. Mary's?

The book of 1 Corinthians is a letter from Paul to a church that he started which addresses several difficult topics, a variety of concerns, and with contrasting views and expectations which was causing division. This is most likely one of at least four letters that Paul wrote (we have two of them as part of Scripture). It lays down principles, and instructions that can be applied to every local expression of church. At its heart is a call for them to stand united for Jesus: God's church, God's way.

What might God want to say at this time to us here at All Saints and St. Mary's as we seek to follow him together?

The hope for this series is to be more than a general Bible Study of what we can learn from the book of 1 Corinthians. We are deliberately focussing on some parts of the letter more than others (but that doesn't stop you doing your own study on the other parts). Ultimately in this series we are asking the question: What might God want to say at this time to us here at All Saints and St. Mary's as we seek to follow him together?

Following our APCM on 12th May, we say a huge thank you to Jasmine who has now stepped down as church warden after a three year term. Brian Cuthbert is kindly continuing for another term and Graham Hooper has taken on the second church warden role. Please see below the list of appointed people.


#### 1 Peter 2:24:

## Gifts from The Spirit

1 Corinthians 12: 4-11

There are different kinds of gifts, but the same Spirit distributes them. There are different kinds of service, but the same Lord. There are different kinds of working, but in all of them and in everyone it is the same God at work.

Now to each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good. To one there is given through the Spirit a message of wisdom, to another a message of knowledge by means of the same Spirit, to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by that one Spirit, to another miraculous powers, to another prophecy, to another distinguishing between spirits, to another speaking in different kinds of tongues, and to still another the interpretation of tongues. All these are the work of one and the same Spirit, and he distributes them to each one, just as he determines.
