Sermon Series: Summer Term 2024 - The Book of 1 Corinthians

Church is a people with purpose ... But what does it mean to be fully united in the purpose that Jesus give us, and how do we do that here at All Saints and St. Mary's?

The book of 1 Corinthians is a letter from Paul to a church that he started which addresses several difficult topics, a variety of concerns, and with contrasting views and expectations which was causing division. This is most likely one of at least four letters that Paul wrote (we have two of them as part of Scripture). It lays down principles, and instructions that can be applied to every local expression of church. At its heart is a call for them to stand united for Jesus: God's church, God's way.

The hope for this series is to be more than a general Bible Study of what we can learn from the book of 1 Corinthians. We are deliberately focussing on some parts of the letter more than others (but that doesn't stop you doing your own study on the other parts). Ultimately in this series we are asking the question: What might God want to say at this time to us here at All Saints and St. Mary's as we seek to follow him together?

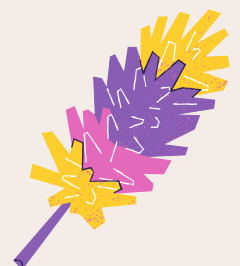

We would appreciate some extra help for this spring clean, if you could spare two hours on the 19th it would be much appreciated.

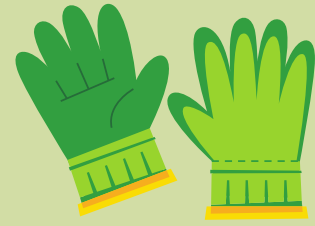

Pathways Mission Partners Report June 2024

Pathways provide accommodation, therapy and mentorship for 21 residents; all have addiction issues. Every resident engages in the Pathways Day programme with the assistance of senior peer roles. Daily activities offered include The 12 Step Programme, Goals & Affirmations, Employability and training courses that run in tandem with counselling and therapy sessions for physical, mental health and addiction issues.

In the last year Pathways has been able to successfully find "move-on" accommodation for 8 former residents as well as securing employment in various sectors amongst them are Telesales, builder, delivering vans, estate agency and starting up their own business in painting property exteriors.

Pathways has never been ashamed of the preaching the gospel, it is an integral part of their mission. The fruits of their labour have resulted in 50% of those who have part of this ministry have either made a commitment to Jesus or believes in a God and prays.

A new support worker, Martin has recently joined them and is settling in well.

Pathways is thankful for the support given to them by Hampreston in both prayer and the regular monthly donations.

Pathways currently face a challenging time as their fundraiser has taken a sabbatical year out and it is uncertain if they will return. One of the trustees has stepped in but they have no experience in this area.

Prayer Requests :

1. An application has been lodged for Housing Benefit, BCP have changed the way they make payments. Please pray that the application for rental payments for the residents will be approved.
2. A person will step in to be a fund raiser who has relevant experience to maintain the level of excellence for housing, support and professional care needed to run Pathways.
3. That Pathways will continue to offer this practical ministry and preach the gospel of Jesus to heal, set free and provide a hope and a future to those who seek freedom from addiction.

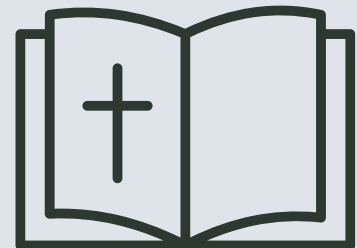
