The passionate pursuit of a life following Jesus

A Bible-based teaching series for the Autumn Term

What does it look like when an individual has a heart completely on fire for Jesus?

Let's be a church on fire, fully surrendered to following God's purposes. This can only be done in his strength and is always about our hearts. It requires laying things down and submitting to him but experiencing deep gifts for God and his provision along the way. 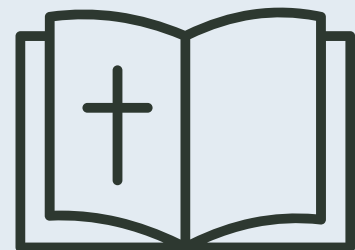
Continue to pray for strength and recovery for Pauline.

Reading

John 6: 25-35

Jesus is The Bread of Life



When they found him on the other side of the lake, they asked him, "Rabbi, when did you get here?" Jesus answered, "Very truly I tell you, you are looking for me, not because you saw the signs I performed but because you ate the loaves and had your fill. Do not work for food that spoils, but for food that endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you. For on him God the Father has placed his seal of approval."

Then they asked him, "What must we do to do the works God requires?" Jesus answered, "The work of God is this: to believe in the one he has sent."

So they asked him, "What sign then will you give that we may see it and believe you? What will you do? Our ancestors ate the manna in the wilderness; as it is written: 'He gave them bread from heaven to eat.'" Jesus said to them, "Very truly I tell you, it is not Moses who has given you the bread from heaven, but it is my Father who gives you the true bread from heaven. For the bread of God is the bread that comes down from heaven and gives life to the world." "Sir," they said, "always give us this bread."

Then Jesus declared, "I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never go hungry, and whoever believes in me will never be thirsty."
