Activating Faith: The Story of Abraham

Activating our Faith

"Abraham believed God, and it was credited to him as righteousness, and he was called God's friend" – James 2:23

Abraham, along with his father, Terah, was called away from his home. They moved part way, and then settled. Later on, after Terah died, Abraham picked up the call again. He never became a leader of people or a ruler of a nation, though he prospered materially.

Abraham didn't always make good or wise decisions. He and his wife Sarah encountered tensions, difficulties and experienced many trials. He never became a leader of people or ruler of a nation, although they prosper financially. But God's call was for him to become the spiritual father of the children of God's chosen people. Abraham was called to be a blessing to the whole world.

Their travels had a spiritual dimension, with the call to establish a people of promise, and into a promised land. It was their faith that made them stand out from the others. God called, and they obeyed.

The story of Abraham is found in Genesis, but he is mentioned over sixty times across the New Testament. Faith in God is the golden thread which runs through the narrative of the story.

Through this series we will be seeking God as to what it means for us to activate our own faith, to receive God's blessing, and to follow a call in being a blessing to others.

Abraham trusted God. He chose faith, even against what may be perceived as human 'wisdom'. Abraham was blessed to be a blessing.
